





Update To Ebenezer Hope Ministries School Building Project in Africa

The first classroom building for this project, built with your donations, was recently completed, and classes were started in early 2025.

- Currently there are 180 students in four classrooms, 84 girls and 96 boys.
- While many of these students are refugees in the Nakivale Camp, there are 20 students able to pay tuition of 18,000 Ugandan Shillings.
- These tuition payments are supporting the operation of the school.

Ministry Shares Fundraising Update

We refer to this amount as our Ministry Share, and it's used for mission and outreach — both nationally and internationally. Our Ministry Share money is also used for a variety of trainings, as well as our Conference Resource Center — a library that provides resources for our Sunday School and Small Groups. Additionally, our church has benefitted from grants provided by Conference agencies. During our Ministry Shares Campaign this month, our church collected \$2,034! This is exciting, and we hope you will keep Ministry Share giving in your mind going forward. There will continue to be brightly labelled envelopes in our chair
