

# Stewardship Update

### 2020 Campaign Off to Good Start

December marks the time when church Leadership puts together the budget for the coming year. On Commitment Sunday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, we collected 51 pledges amounting to \$132,058. This is a great start against our goal of \$348,138 – we are 38% to our goal!

THANK YOU to everyone who has committed a pledge of financial support. These committed dollars help us to make informed decisions about how we can support our ministries.

We will continue to accept pledges through November... and if you are reading this in December and still haven't pledged, it's not too late! Every Pledge counts and is important to the ministries we support.

### **Another Milestone!**

The church mortgage just went under \$1 million!! Even though we still have a long way to go, the end is getting a lot closer! The construction cost was \$3.1 million, so we've come a long way. We've also been able to do many things with all the extra space! We are so grateful to all who have made this possible. We hope to have your continued support as we head toward the day when we can burn the mortgage!

### **Auction Raised Almost \$3,000!**

The Annual Auction held on Friday, November 15<sup>th</sup> was a wonderful night of fellowship, food and fun. We also raised a bunch of money. It takes a lot of people to pull off an Auction...so big thanks go out to Jan Winter, Tracy

As of this writing, we don't have the final figures, but preliminary numbers have us making about \$3,000. This money will be split between AUMC Ministry Shares and the AUMC Building Fund.

The church now hots three craft workshops during the year where crafters pay money to rent table space and work on their projects. All of the money raised is donated to the church. It has been used to update the lighting in the Ide Center and to purchase this year's cantata. The cost of the recent piano moving and the cost of the piano tuning was also covered. In addition, the funds have covered new furniture for the Youth Room, plus many other items that couldn't be covered with regular budget money.

The people who attend the Crafting Workshop are not primarily Aldersgate attendees. Karen Sladden and Sue Galligan are the organizers for these events. This has become a great fundraiser for the church!

# Christmas Eve Play Opportunity for Children!


