

Aldersgate Ministry During the Corona Pandemic

Our church building is closed for gatherings during the Coronavirus Pandemic, but ministry is not closed. Ministries are being carried out in new ways. I am so amazed and feel blessed with faith, passion, dedication, commitment, faithfulness and creativity of the people of Aldersgate Church. I would like to take an opportunity to share what is going on in Aldersgate Church during the Coronavirus Pandemic.

Worship Service

Aldersgate Church has been doing weekly worship online using Aldersgate Facebook. Every Sunday morning, a worship video is posted on the church Facebook at 8am. The link to the worship video is posted on the church website, www.aumcgreece.org on Sunday morning. The link is also shared through church email.

Our music staff has been absolutely amazing. With their faith, gifts and commitment, they bring wonderful online worship to the Aldersgate congregation. I am also thankful to all worship participants for Scripture reading, prayers, special music. My special thanks go to our children/youths for their "Christ is risen" videos. They were awesome.

The online worship services have been viewed by 600-800 people each week before Easter. The Easter service has been viewed by more than 1,000 people and visited by more than 1,300 people. We are reaching out to many people. I encourage you to share the worship video with your Facebook friends.

Sermon Script

Sermon script is sent to church members by email on Sunday morning. For those who do not do emails, copies of the sermon script are mailed. If you don't get the sermon script by either email or mail and if you want to receive it, please contact the church office.

Pastoral Care

Pastor and the church office reach out to church members, especially the ones who need pastoral care and the ones who are isolated, by phone call or email. We have not done much so far because worship ministry and some essential tasks have been the major areas of ministry. Knowing the importance of communication and keeping relationships among church family members, we will put more effort on this ministry.

Prayer Ministry

Prayer ministry has been an important ministry in these challenging times. Many people are sharing their prayer concerns and the members of the Prayer Chain are praying with and for them. 



Who would imagine that COVID-19 would cause us NOT to use our beautiful church to congregate, socialize and celebrate the word of God. I can only speak for myself but as a Trustee I am at a loss to not have the activity and love of people in the building I care for. With patience, this time will pass and we will all be together in God's House.

The Trustees do still meet and are aware of needs. Please let us know if you happen to be there and notice something. Jean Paul is currently not employed due to lack of work, so again, if you are at the church and notice a need, please consider taking care of it — wiping, vacuuming etc. Jean Paul will return when the building is back in use.

We plan to have a May 16 Spring cleaning day from 9 am-2 pm. We ask that people continue to do the social distancing while working around the building and yard. If you are not able to make that day or choose to do some work alone — there is a lot of raking and cleaning out of flower bed areas to be done. The church has rakes and lawn paper bags that can be used — reach out to Adam Pfund if you need them.

We continue to need security checkers. Each evening someone walks through the building to ensure it is safe and secure. We continue to wait to hear about a grant that was submitted to cover the cost of new thermostats and additional facility repairs. We should hear something by the end of June! Please pray we are awarded these funds.


