From the Pastor

I love crocuses — the first flowers to bloom each spring. Their cheery blossoms open when there's still snow on the ground. They are the harbingers of spring.

Crocus flowers are the symbol of new life, new beginnings and joy thanks to their early blooming flowers in spring. They give us the conviction that new life and

new beginnings come forth even when it seems that there is no hope.

That is what the journey of Lent is about. It begins on Ash Wednesday, March 2 this year. 


